News from the Health Office

Application for JSPS

If you are injured at school and visit a medical facility, you will be reimbursed for medical expenses. All students in the school's regular course are enrolled in the program. If you have any injuries that have not yet been filed, please notify the Health Office. Applications can be made for two years from the date of the medical examination. If you have an injury that you applied for in middle school and is still ongoing, or if you have an injury that requires medical attention after graduation, please notify the Health Office so that you can file a claim for 10 years after you apply.
